



Cobá & Punta Laguna Nature Reserve

Private Tour to Cobá Ruins | Jungle Walk | Exploration in the Punta Laguna Nature and Spider Monkey Reserve | Cenote

A day full of culture and nature. See the impressive 42 meter tall temple at the archeological site of Cobá and the protected area and nature reserve "Otoch Ma'ax Yetel Kooh", which means the home of the spider monkey and puma in Mayan. Learn about the flora, fauna and heritage of the region, see cute monkeys in the wild and maybe encounter other animals on the way.

Tour Itinerary

9:00 Explore the Mayan ruins of Cobá

The day starts in the mystical ancient Mayan city - hundreds of years ago one of the largest settlements of the area. You walk through the jungle, explore the remains of ancient buildings and travel back to the time in which this place was a thriving town with one of the tallest temples of the old Mayan empire.



11:30 Enjoy an Authentic Brunch

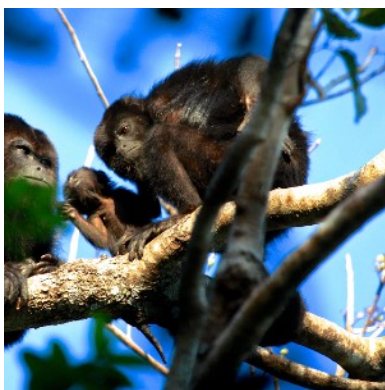

14:00 Refresh Yourself in a Cenote

Jump into a cenote and have a delicious swim in the sacred waters stored in the porous limestone caves of the region. Cenotes are also the entrance to the Mayan underworld Xibalbá.



15:30 Visit the Punta Laguna Nature and Spider Monkey Reserve

We close the day with a wild adventure: deep in nature you can see the two monkey species of the region roaming free in the trees. Learn about the flora and fauna and be enchanted by the abundant nature of a still untouched piece of the Yucatán Peninsula.
