The protected area and biosphere Sian Ka'an south of Tulum is all about the element water: Many lagoons and channels cut through the mangroves until they reach the Caribbean Sea. Dive deep into nature and go floating in the crystal-clear channels. Also learn about the ancient Mayan civilization, see wild animals on the way and learn about the diverse ecosystems.

Tour Itinerary

9:00 Explore the Mayan ruins of Muyil

How was life in the jungle hundreds of years ago? Get a feeling of it when you visit the archeological site of Muyil - one of the earliest and longest inhabited ancient Mayan settlements on the eastern coast of the Yucatán peninsula.



10:30 Make a Jungle Walk

What makes Muyil so unique, too, is that it's connected with the Sian Ka'an nature reserve. On a walk through the jungle you will learn about the native civilization and get in touch with the tropical flora & fauna.



11:30 Boat Ride & Floating

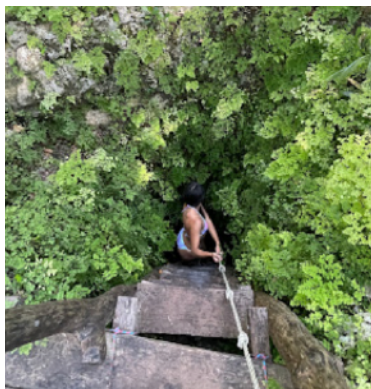
You will reach a precious freshwater lagoon and hop onto a boat. After the ride through the mangrove channels, with some wildlife spotting follows the highlight: let yourself float in the soft current of the refreshing healing waters.
